Tea

Nepal has a long history of Tea cultivation, initiated with the establishment of Ilam Tea Estate in the Hills of Ilam District in 1863. However, it is believed by historians that the first Tea bushes in Nepal were grown from seeds which were given as a gift by the Chinese Emperor to the then Prime Minister and de facto ruler of Nepal, Jung Bahadur Rana. It is believed that Tea plantation in Nepal started within the same decade when it was introduced in Darjeeling Hills of India. Nepal grows mainly 3 types of tea, i.e. Camellia assamica and C. asamica spp lasio- calyx for CTC and Camellia Sinensis for orthodox tea. Nepali orthodox tea is somewhat similar to Darjeeling Tea in its appearance, aroma and fruity taste. The reason for the similarity is that the eastern zones of Nepal, which are the main tea producing regions of Nepal, have more or less the same geographical and topographical conditions as the Darjeeling and are juxtaposed to each other. However, Nepal's teas do stand apart from the Darjeeling Tea. Tea connoisseurs consider some of the Teas from Nepal to be much better than the Darjeeling Tea in its aroma, fusion, taste, and colour. The biodiversity, topography and organic matter richest soil place Nepal Tea in a unique position.

Black Tea

Black tea is cherished globally as one of the most popular and widely enjoyed beverages. White tea is harvested from the youngest tea leaves and buds, often picked during the early spring when they are still covered in fine white hairs, giving the tea its name. These tender leaves are gently withered and dried, undergoing minimal oxidation compared to other types of tea. This minimal processing helps to preserve the natural antioxidants and delicate flavour compounds present in the tea leaves.

Nestled in this ideal ecological environment of high mountains, our coffee is shade-grown, bird-friendly, and handpicked, resulting in a flavour and aroma that are truly distinctive. From cultivation through to packaging, our coffee undergoes meticulous processing by skilled technicians, ensuring that every cup delivers a product of the highest quality.





Himalayan Beans

Himalayan beans are a unique variety cultivated in the hilly regions of Nepal using organic farming methods, resulting in their distinct and authentic flavor. Known as the superfood of Nepal, they are packed with proteins and fiber.





Himalayan Red Lentils

Cardamom

Nepali large cardamom (Amomum Subulatum Roxburgh.) also known as 'black gold' or 'black cardamom' and locally called alainchi - belongs to the botanical family called Zingiberaceae. Large cardamoms are spindle-shaped pods that are light to dark brown in colour. The pods normally vary from 20 mm to 35 mm in size and contain several black seeds inside with a spicy aroma. It is an evergreen, perennial and herbaceous plant grown on north-facing hill slopes. The plant is sensitive to climate and requires temperatures of 15-25 degrees Celsius. It also needs humid conditions and shade and grows between 800 and 2,100 meters.1 Plants survive for 20 to 25 years. They start fruiting from their third year and mature at 8-10 years, with a full fruit bearing period of 17 to 22 years. This type of large cardamom is grown mainly in the Himalayan region of Nepal, Sikkim in India, and Bhutan.



Turmeric

Turmeric, scientifically known as Curcuma longa, is a flowering plant belonging to the ginger family, Zingiberaceae. Native to the Indian subcontinent and Southeast Asia, turmeric has been cultivated for thousands of years for its culinary, medicinal, and ceremonial purposes. It is one of the most extensively researched herbs due to its numerous potential health benefits.

Our ongoing commitment is to support small village farmers from Nepal's hilly regions, bridging them to global markets through our platform, ensuring that quality meets quantity.

Our supplements are meticulously sourced from the remote hilly regions of Jumla and Humla, where farmers endure months in icy conditions to handpick organic Cordyceps plants (Yarsagumba). These plants are gathered at central collection points and then transported to our ISO-certified laboratory, where their extracts are meticulously processed to create our supplements.

Our beans are sourced collectively from Jumla, Humla, Kalikot, Dolpa, and Mustang, where small village farmers cultivate their crops using organic methods.

Tea and coffee are sourced from the eastern Nepalese regions of Ilam and Nuwakot. Every leaf of tea and every coffee bean is grown organically and handpicked by skilled professionals and technicians, ensuring top-notch quality from cultivation through to packaging.








Our Team
